

## Checklist: What to Do When a Loved One Dies

## Before the Funeral Within 30 Days of the Death ☐ What are the burial plans/wishes? Complete an inventory of all assets ☐ Who is in charge of the burial? Determine debts owed Secure real estate and personal property ☐ Taxes Is it locked? Mortgages, other secured debt Credit cards, consumer debt ■ Make arrangements for pets Utilities Secure will and other documents Medical bills Request death certificates (15 originals) Funeral expense Shortly After Death Other unpaid bills Meet with a law firm to discuss next steps and Confirm titling of assets in the trust timeline File claims for life insurance death benefits Gather property and asset information such as deeds, account statements, and life insurance Make initial investment decisions Determine what bills are outstanding Go to cash, short-term investments, or adjust longterm investments ☐ Have mail forwarded Order appraisals Locate and inventory safe deposit box Real estate (unless planning to sell immediately) Contact liability insurance agent, make sure Other assets (if estate tax return needed) there is valid insurance coverage ☐ Notify all advisors Tax Accountant Financial planners Collect and cancel all credit cards Obtain EIN (tax number) for the trust Open up an operating account for the trust
